I CURRICULUM VITAE

1 Biography

Robert Nicolaas (Rob) Eisinga was born in Heerlen on May 26, 1959. He obtained his MAVO certificate at the St. Janscollege in Hoensbroek in 1975, studied HAVO-4 (1976) at the Romboutscollege in Brunssum, and received his Atheneum-B2 certificate from the Romboutscollege in 1978. In 1979 he began to study Sociology at the Radboud University Nijmegen (RU). On October 1st, 1985 he graduated (*cum laude*) in Mathematical Sociology with minors in Mathematical Psychology and Organizational Sociology. He was a junior researcher in the Department of Social Science Research Methods of the RU Nijmegen from October 1985 to January 1990. On June 16th, 1989 he took his PhD in Social Sciences from the RU Nijmegen. He has held two Fellowships of the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences (KNAW): a three-year Junior Fellowship from January 1990 to December 1992 and a two-year Senior Fellowship from January 1993 to December 1994. He became Assistant Professor of Quantitative Research Methods, in particular Longitudinal Data Analysis, at the Department of Social Science Research Methods of the RU Nijmegen in January 1995, and he was appointed Professor of Longitudinal Analysis of Social Change at the RU Nijmegen in June 1997. He is since January 1995 member of the KNAW-certified national Dutch research and training centre ICS (Inter-University Centre for Social Science Theory and Methodology). He has been director of the NVAO-accredited MSc research master program Social and Cultural Science of the RU Nijmegen from November 2007 to August 2016.

Rob Eisinga is one of the staff members of the SOCON research group at the Radboud University Nijmegen, running the bi-decadal national Dutch survey ‘Social and Cultural Developments in the Netherlands’ since the late 1970s. He incorporated several Dutch instruments into cross-national surveys such as the International Social Survey Program (ISSP) and he has been national coordinator for the Netherlands of the European Social Survey (ESS) Round I (2003-04: back-up) and Round II (2004-05). He has ample experience with all stages of survey research (field work preparation, data collection, compilation, documentation, analysis, publication) and his substantive interests and publications cover topics relating to religion, political voting and ethnic prejudice, viewed from the perspective of large scale (inter-) national and longitudinal data files. He combines his interest in social surveys and social change with a main interest in quantitative research methods and survey methodology. He has written articles and textbook chapters on statistical methods including structural equation modeling, regression, panel and time series analysis and Markov transition models and on methodological issues such as ecological inference, 2×2 ecological tables in particular, measurement invariance and interviewer bias and effects. His current methodological interest concerns the exact distribution of rank data statistics. Current substantive interests include electoral bellwethers, body mass index and the obesity epidemic, all from a methodological perspective.
